WASHINGTON (AP)—The U.S. Navy denied Thursday that there are any defectors Soviet naval officers in Washington giving intelligence information about the Soviet Navy.

A dispatch from Bristol, R.I., had quoted Cmdr. Harvey O. Webster of the office of chief of naval operations as telling a Rotary Club luncheon that two high-ranking Soviet naval officers had defected, were in Washington and

had confirmed American estimates of Soviet naval strength. "The navy has no knowledge of the defection of a Russian captain and commander to this country," a spokesman said. "The definitely are some in Washington. The only Russian naval officers known to be in Washington are those attached to the Russian Embassy."

The Bristol story quoted Webster as identifying one of the Russian defectors as Lt. I. Predtetsky. This officer left Russia last March and had several contacts with Western newspaper men. The navy spokesman said he is not in the United States.

Webster had been quoted as saying the Soviets have atomic submarines. In a speech in New York Thursday, Rear Adm. H. G. Rickover, head of the navy's atomic propulsion division, said that so far as is known the Soviets do not have an atomic submarine but it has been assumed that they will have one soon.
