

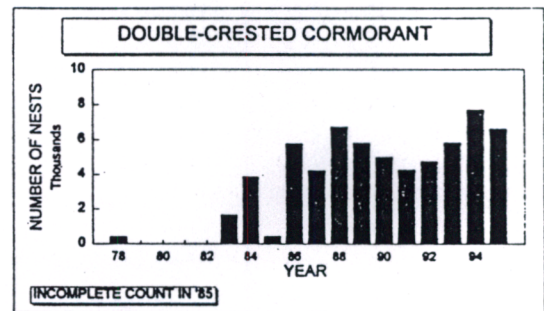
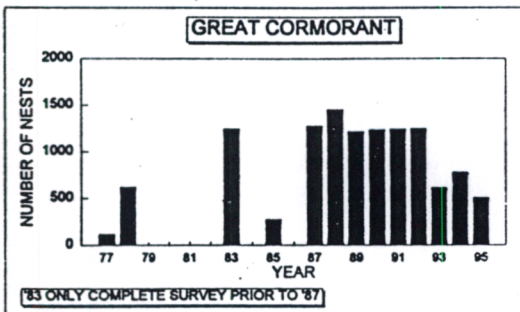
Coar Reports: 2 Fox Sparrows at Stratford on Apr. 7 (WC).
