**PROGRESSIVE IDEAS.**

Notes of the **Forward Movement in the Great West.**

This list of new uses of aluminum as of electricity, continues to rapidly extend. The metal is said to be especially adapted to a food-supplying medium. It does not darken, as other materials used for this purpose. Whole sets of teeth, indeed, have, it is asserted, been experimentally made of aluminum, the result of which has been to place before the dentist for solution the problem of rendering the metal grinders the color of the natural enamel.

**Curtains Made of Glass.**

Glass curtains, colored London Venetians, are being used in household furnishings. They are in obscurity, and have the effect, when closed, of stained glass. They consist of a series of little squares of colored glass, each set in a small zinc frame, the squares being attached to each other at the four corners by little S-shaped hooks. We are told that they can be easily taken down and moved as any other curtains, and, in case of changing from one size of window to another, can easily be enlarged or decreased in size by the addition or subtraction of a certain number of squares. They are also easily cleaned, and one of their particular attractions is said to be cheapness.

**Power from a Swiss River.**

An important scheme for the transmission of power is now being considered in Switzerland. It is proposed to dam the River Reusse and convey the water to a storage and distributing reservoir having a capacity of 3,000,000 cubic feet, and situated at Combe Garrot. From here the water is to be distributed to the communities of the Canton of Valais, La Chaux-de-Fonds. The power will be distributed from the turbine stations by electricity, the distances being from 7 1/2 to 11 miles.

**England to Build "Biggest" Warship.**

Work will soon be commenced at the Royal Dockyard, at Chatham, for the construction of the new two-deck screw first-class armored battleship to be named the *Magnificent*, which will be the largest and most powerful battleship ever constructed at that dockyard, being longer and wider than the vessels of the Royal Sovereign and Hood class.

**Connecting Copenhagen With the Mainland.**

Copenhagen, owing to its isolated position in the Isle of Zealand, is cut off, not only from a portion of Danish territory, but from the shores of Schleswig-Holstein and from the Continent generally, by the waters of the Baltic, and the two islands of that sea known respectively as the Great and Little Belts. In fact, during winter time the water communication is seriously interfered with by the gathering of the ice in the frozen north. Danish engineers are considering the project of the establishment of a direct communication with the continent by means of a bridge over the Little Belt and a tunnel eleven miles long under the Great Belt.

**Gas Statistics of Great Britain.**

The estimated capital employed in gas manufacture in Great Britain has reached the large sum of \$85,000,000. The quantity of gas sold in London amounts to 30,000 million cubic feet, and the consumption of gas in the United Kingdom during 1892 reached the high figure of 100,000 million cubic feet, showing an increase of 50 per cent. during the past 10 years. The coal used for gas alone amounts to about 13,000,000 tons.

**Lord Salisbury's French Villa.**

Lord Salisbury, as usual at this time of the year, says the *London Sun*, has retired to his French villa, the *Chalet Cecil*, which is situated about a mile or so from Dieppe, at the top of the beautiful white chalk cliff which stretches opposite the equally white coast of England, from Saint Valery to Trouville. With its crenellated towers and stout walls surrounding the property, the place has the appearance of a fortress. It is essentially laid out with a view to comfort. **Not long since the Chalet Cecil, much to the surprise of the good people around, was desecrated by a vulgar board announcing that the property was for sale, but this was shortly after removed, for though Lord Salisbury has built on the Riviera a larger and more imposing residence, this is only suitable for the late autumn and winter, and he still retains at Dieppe within sight of the native shores.**

**Russia's Regiments of Specialists.**

An account is given in the *Vienna Presse* of what is described as the formation of a new class of regiments in Russia, and unknown to even in military circles out of Russia. They are called the *Corps de Chasseurs*, formed of a particular class of Russian soldiers, numbering sixty-four to each infantry regiment. They are picked men, chosen for various reasons, and include not only the men of best education, but also the best runners, sharpshooters, fencers, swimmers, climbers, sappers, fishermen, and hunters. They are under a strict discipline of their own, but they are not obliged to march in line, are free from barrack service, and are excused sentry duty, so that they may be called at any moment to the extraordinary service for which they are trained. As pioneers they build bridges across the broadest and deepest rivers in Russia; as hunters and fishermen they provide the army with game and fish. During long marches they are the tinter of the wolf, the bear and the tiger. In the military districts of Vilna, Warsaw and Kielce, that is, along the frontier of Austria and Germany, the *Corps de Chasseurs* in 1868. The *Corps de Chasseurs* of the regiments in Minsk and Mohileff are considered the best in the army.—*St. James Gazette*.

**A Big Mistake.**

The moulting season, or the season when the hens shed their feathers will soon be at hand. The process is one that in certain respects debilitates and prevents hens from laying. The reason of this is that the growing of new feathers requires all the nitrogen and phosphates contained in the food and there is none left to form the egg. A curious fact about the hen, and one that illustrates the foregoing statement, is this, if a hen's leg is broken during the laying season, she will lay her eggs without shells until the break is mended. The reason for this must be that all the lime contained in the food is used for the mending of the broken bone, there is therefore none for the formation of egg shells. The formation of new feathers does not require any carbonaceous or fat producing food, consequently well fed hens can lay very fat during the moulting. Many farmers and poultry raisers not understanding all about these things kill their old hens because they think they have stopped laying and are fat. This is a great mistake, because if the proper material be furnished them with their food to supply the increased demand for nitrogen and phosphates before mentioned, the hens will be recovered to their old habits, sooner and will begin laying on the approach of cold weather and will continue to lay vigorously all winter, while the young pullets, reserved to take the place of the old ones, may not begin to lay until much later in the season.
