**Pope Raps Birth Control In Elevating Cardinals**

VATICAN CITY (AP) — In formally naming eight new cardinals this week, Pope John warned anew against communism and declared that artificial birth control is not the answer to the problem of hunger in the world.

"Lethal limitation of offspring" cannot be condoned, the Pope said.

The new cardinals included two American archbishops, Albert Gregory Meyer of Chicago and Archbishop Aloisius Muench of Fargo, N.D. This gives the United States a record six cardinals, reflecting the growth of American Catholicism in the last century.

The creation of the new cardinals at a secret consistory raised the total in the College of Cardinals to a historic high of 79. In addition to the Americans, those elevated to the college were: William T. Heard, 75-year-old Scottish-born convert to Catholicism who has been dean of the Holy Roman Rota for many years; German-born Agostino Bea, Jesuit confessor of the late Pius XII; Francesco Morano, 87-year-old secretary of the ecclesiastical tribunal; Gustavo Testa, 73-year-old Italian apostolic nuncio to Switzerland; Spanish-born Arcadio Larraona, secretary of the Vatican's Congre-

gation of the Religions; and Paolo Marcella, 64-year-old Italian apostolic nuncio to France.

The Pope delivered his allocution—or solemn address—to 33 members of the college cloistered with him in the Vatican palace's Consistory Hall. The new cardinals were not present, but received their notification later from a papal messenger.

"For a great part of humanity," the Pope said, "the problem of hunger is still grave. In any case, to seek a remedy to this very grave calamity, there can not be any adoption of erroneous doctrines and harmful methods and lethal limitation of offspring."

"Instead, all riches which come from the earth should be put at the disposal of all, according to

the order of God and Justice." The pontiff did not mention communism by name, but his warning was clear as he said: "In a particular way our thoughts and anxious affection turn to that part of our flock which still is denied the possibility of practicing its faith fully and publicly."

"We embrace with most ardent love all those people among whom the laws of God are violated and the most elementary rights of human liberty and conscience are oppressed."
