## MARKETS

### N. Y. Stocks

NEW YORK (AP)—The stock market punched its way upward this week toward a new record high mark. One more short advance, and the market will complete the full cycle of a major correction.

It was on March 4 that The Associated Press average of 60 stocks touched the highest point in its history \$162.60, a level that overshadowed the storied peaks of 1929.

Then it tumbled swiftly for six days in a major correction. Abruptly the rally got under way. The market continued upward with hardly a pause for the next two weeks. Then the recovery bogged down.

This week the market broke loose and advanced without fanfare to near-record heights. There were only four trading days with the market closed for Good Friday.
