 Today's declarer left himself "wide open," but a defender was not alert.
 North dealer.
 North-South vulnerable.

West led the diamond ten. The ace won, and South led to the spade ace. Another spade went to East's king, and East returned a high diamond. South ruffed, then trumped a spade with dummy's eight. East overtrumped and continued diamonds. Again South ruffed, and another spade was trumped in dummy, leaving this position:

The heart king was led, and if South had overtaken and cashed the heart jack, then finessed clubs, he would have been safe. But he chose to let the heart king hold. Now, when the club king was led from dummy, East went wrong! He ruffed, and that was the end of the defense. South trumped East's diamond return, drew the last trumps, and then could take the established club finesse.
 It will be observed that South could have conducted the play far more efficiently, but as the play did go, East had an outstanding opportunity to defeat the hand by discarding on dummy's club king and waiting to ruff the club ace.
