## Don Applicants

All students wishing to apply for a position as Don for the year 1981-82 may do so by picking up an application form from the university Canada Employment Centre, first floor, Main Building.

1. Open to all UPEI students who meet the following qualifications:
  - a) at least one year in residence.
  - b) preferably a Junior or Senior student (as designated by the registrar's office).
  - c) have a satisfactory academic standing.
  - d) possess a sound knowledge of the university, residences, program offerings and student activities.

2. Salary \$1,000 or \$1,200 (\$500 or \$600 per semester depending on the residence).

3. Terms of Appointment: Dons are appointed for the academic year, September 1 to May 1 approximately. During this period they have the use of a private room in residence and receive a stipend. A job description is available along with the application form at the employment centre.

All applications must be completed and returned to the university Canada Employment Centre not later than April 3, 1981. Interviews to be held the week of April 6, 1981.
