Abegweit Football Team Of 1886



Dr. H. H. Shaw Recalls Birth Of Football In P. E. Island

The year 1885 marked the birth of football in Prince Edward Island though it was not until the following year that the Abegweit Football Club was formed here. It was in 1885 that young men like Kenneth Martin and George Robinson from Dalhousie University and William Weeks and Harry Johnston from McGill brought back stories of football games and fired the enthusiasm of college students here.

Among the men to carry the goal posts and cross bars to the field was Dr. H. H. Shaw, B.Sc., LL.D., retired Superintendent of Education, the only surviving member of the original Abegweit football team. With him were Percy MacDonald, Hooper Robinson and Charles Kennedy.
