Gold Mining in Nova Scotia.

There is now quite a boom at the newly discovered gold mines at Lochaber, near Sheet Harbor. An English company has commenced operations. Thirteen buildings have been erected and some thirty or forty persons are engaged in constructing a road. A brick of gold weighing sixty-four ounces, the result of one and a half day's crushing from thirteen tons of quartz, from Douglas & Co.'s mine at North Brookfield, was taken to Bridgewater the other day. This is the property sold by W. J. Nelson to Douglas & Co. Brookfield is a rich gold district, and is bound to be a bonanza. Malaga is still booming, and a mining town is rapidly growing up there, having now a population of about four hundred.—*Ex.*
