FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

Are financial concerns interfering with your studies? There may be help available. UPEI Student Services has bursary and scholarship information. The following awards' application deadlines are quickly approaching, so act now before it's too late!

Canada-Taiwan Scholarship Program. These scholarships are for Canadian citizens enrolled full-time at a Canadian university. The award includes return airfare to Taiwan, tuition, monthly allowance, and travel assurance. The deadline is March 31, 1997.

Canadian Unity Essay Contest. Canadians university and college students are invited to submit an essay on Canadian Unity. There will be two prizes of \$200 and the deadline is March 31.

PEI Recreation & Sports Association for the Physically Challenged. This bursary is for a physically-challenged resident of PEI who is enrolled full-time in post-secondary education and has some involvement in recreation/sport in Community/School/Other. The deadline is May 15, 1997.

Phyllis P. Harris Scholarship. This \$2500 award is for a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant who has worked or volunteered in the general field of human sexuality and who intend to work in the area of family planning or population issues. The application deadline is April 1, 1997.

Norman Barwin Scholarship. This \$2500 Award is for an honors or equivalent graduate who intends to work in the field of reproductive health. The deadline is April 1, 1997.

Roger Cairns Scholarship. This award is for students who plan to attend UPEI for their third or fourth year in 1997-1998 and who are abstainers from tobacco, alcohol, and non-medicinal drugs. They must be either candidates for work in Protestant denominations, candidates for work in Catholic Church, or intending to enter dentistry, medicine, or nursing. The deadline for applications is May 30, 1997.

Prince Edward Island Law Student Scholarship: For an Island student who is enrolled or accepted for enrolment as a full-time law student for 1997-98. The deadline for applications is July 31, 1997.

Canadian Forces Personnel Assistance Fund: A loan program to assist serving and former members and their dependents with costs of post secondary education. Applications are available from Canadian Forces Base Financial Counsellors, offices of Veteran Affairs Canada, and Provincial Command Offices of the Royal Canadian Legion.
