Ceremony Set to Open '64 Centennial Events

Scheduled to take place immediately before Premier Walter R. Shaw's New Year's levee, official opening ceremonies will be held at the Charlottetown Hotel on New Year's Day marking the official opening of the

P.E.I. 1964 Centennial Year celebrations. At the function, Dr. Frank MacKinnon, chairman of the P.E.I. centennial committee, will present a 100-pound birthday cake decorated with 100 candles to Premier Shaw. The centennial orator will also be on hand and will read the official Centennial Proclamation. It is expected that Premier Shaw will use the massive birthday cake at his levee DINTINGUISHED GUESTS

On hand for the ceremony will be the Lieutenant-Governor, Hon. W. J. MacDonald; members of the P.E.I. Legislature; the four members of parliament for P.E.I.; the four P.E.I. senators; senior representatives of the Navy, Army, RCMP and the RCMP; His Excellency Most Rev. M.A. MacEachern, bishop of Charlottetown; the president of the P.E.I. Ministerial Association; Rev. W. C. Ball; mayors of P.E.I. municipalities; and representatives of press, radio and TV.

For the actual presentation of the birthday cake, the plans call for the 100-pound cake to be carried in by four men drawn from the Navy, Army, RCMP and the RCMP. "The parade will be led by a piper and the presentation will be made by Dr. MacKinnon. The cake has been presented to the centennial committee for the celebrations by the F.W. Woolworth Co. Ltd.

On hand for the celebration will be the centennial men's choir from Charlottetown under its director, Boston Muford.

Severed Hand Sewn Back On

GALLIPOLIS, Ohio (AP)—Pearley Weaver is recuperating in a Gallipolis hospital with the hope that he might have two usable hands again in a few weeks. Weaver, 53, who lives across the Ohio river in northern Grimms Landing, W.Va., works in a Gallipolis furniture plant. In an accident at work Monday, his right hand was cut off by a machine. It was a clean cut, just above the wrist.

Weaver was taken to Holzer Clinic. His severed hand was brought along wrapped in a cloth. Three surgeons went to work immediately. They put his right hand back on, sewing up blood vessels and attaching muscles and skin back together. It was a four-hour operation. Results still were uncertain today, although Weaver's condition was good.

If Weaver experiences some sense of touch in the hand within the next few days, the doctors say he may regain use of it.
