**"EXPOSING" PARTNER**

The weakest "department" of the average player is his defensive discarding. Specifically, he is far too prone to throw away cards in a suit where he has no strength—thus virtually pointing to his partner and saying, "He is the one to look out for." Today's deal is very much a case in point.

West dealer.  
 Both sides vulnerable.

The bidding:

Beyond doubt, South was gambling the slam, but he certainly had a fine hand after North raised the diamond bid.

West opened a low spade, and South saw that he was on a dangerous ground. Winning with the blank ace, he led a trump to the queen and returned a low club. East put up the ace and shifted

to the deuce of hearts. South won with the ace, took the risk of cashing the club king, and then went to dummy and hopefully ruffed a club. The suit did not break, however, so now everything depended on South's guessing the heart position. He led another trump to dummy—and East committed the egregious error of discarding a heart!

Now, when South led a low heart from the board and East followed with the eight-spot, South had something to go by. If East still had the queen of hearts, then West must have started with a low singleton. Would he not have led that singleton against a slam, in the hope of "hitting" his partner with the ace, instead of leading from a long and obviously weak spade suit? South decided that the singleton lead would have been West's obvious preference, and the conclusion was then clear that West had not held that singleton! So South put up the heart king and dropped West's blank queen.

It is hard to imagine why East thought that he needed all of his spades!

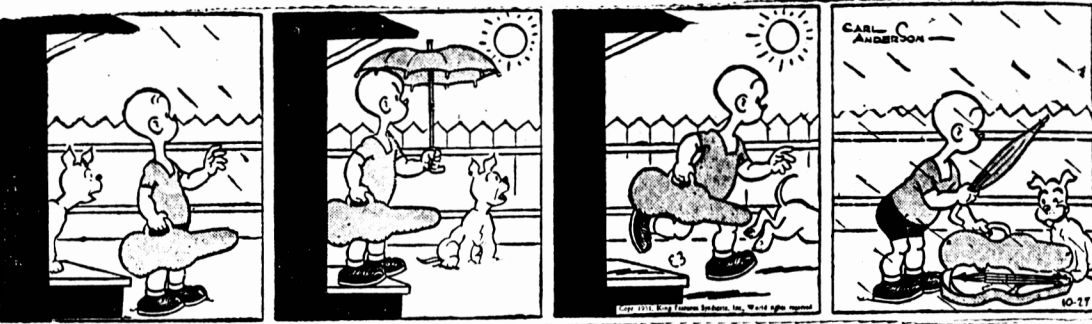
