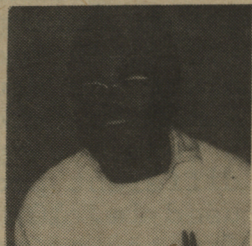
School of Goose Cooking, Duck Pressing, and Other Culinary Peculiarities. Yea, Margie!
