

**ROBIN HOOD IS PARDONED**

NOTTINGHAM, England (Reuters) — Robin Hood and his merry men have gained a free pardon from the sheriff of Nottingham, successor to the man who continually clashed with the legendary outlaw band some 700 years ago.

The sheriff, Alderman Elliott Durham, rode into a thickly wooded area of Sherwood Forest during the weekend to read the brief amnesty proclamation near Robin Hood's reputed hide-out.

His illuminated scroll stated: "I, the sheriff of Nottingham, do hereby exonerate you, Robin Hood, and your archers, from all accusations of acts contrary to law and order of the past."

True he added that his pardon has no legal status because it is not known whether Robin Hood broke the law or whether he ever actually lived.

History and legend contain many versions of how Robin Hood, described variously as a rich rebel nobleman and a man of modest background, roved the huge forest in central England poaching deer, helping outlaws and thwarting the sheriff during the late 13th century.

**Lone Crossing Of Atlantic Takes 44 Days**

CASTLETOWNBERE, Ireland (Reuters) — Lt. Cmdr. George Fairlie has sailed his battered 23-foot boat Dawn Star into this tiny harbor after a lone 44-day crossing of the Atlantic from Nantucket, Mass. Six days ago the gaunt British sailor ran out of fresh water and on arrival had not eaten for 48 hours.

His 2½-ton Bermuda rigged boat was covered with barnacles and had a damaged superstructure after bucking hurricane Faith 350 miles off Newfoundland.

The 43-year-old sailor ran into four more storms before finding shelter on the west coast of Ireland.

Fairlie made the westward voyage in June, sailing to the U.S. by way of the Canary Islands and Barbados.

The trip, he said, was to prove his fitness.

**Walking Upright Being Neglected**

LONDON (AP) — Roger Bannister, the first man to break the four-minute mile barrier said here that people just aren't walking upright any more.

Bannister, now a doctor, told a conference of British physiotherapists:

"I do not want to appear to be running down athletes, but many seem to overlook the elementary point of good posture.

"Athletes are showing a surprising neglect of the importance of a fine carriage and proud gait, respect for which was lost somewhere in the 1920s."

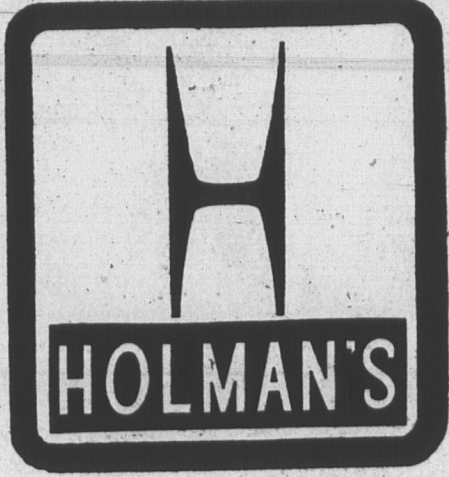

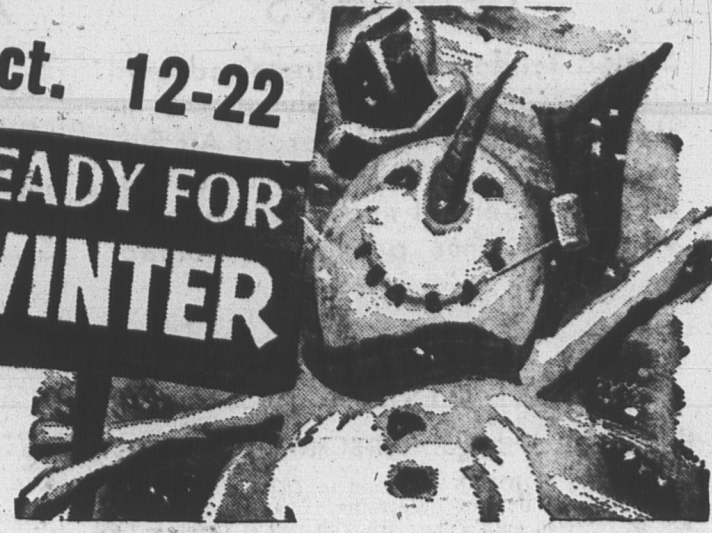
