Ex-Secretary Blaine will go to California in January for the benefit of his health. Mr. Alex. McNeill, M. P., for North Bruce, has returned home from Europe. Twenty tons of turkeys and geese were shipped from Kempsville, Ont., for European markets last week.

All the Rock Island railroad operators in Nebraska and Kansas belonging to the Association struck at 10.30 a. m. on Thursday 183 out of 200 going out. On November 21st 400 tons of No. 1 hard Manitoba wheat was sold in London at 30s. 4d., as compared with 28s. 9d. paid for Kansas Red, the best American Wheat. Good for Canada!

In the Borden murder trial it is alleged that with a single exception the grand jury were unanimous as to the guilt of the accused.
