Sudden Deaths Baffle Doctors

NEW YORK (AP) - Doctors are baffled by the sudden death syndrome of infants.

He calls it the "sudden death syndrome of infants."

The babies, mostly from 10 days to two years old, are from all races, all economic and social classes, and are not concentrated in neighborhoods or families.

Suggested possible causes, he said, include accidental suffocation, infection, invasion of the blood, lack of protective antibodies, virus infection and hypersensitivity to cow's milk.
