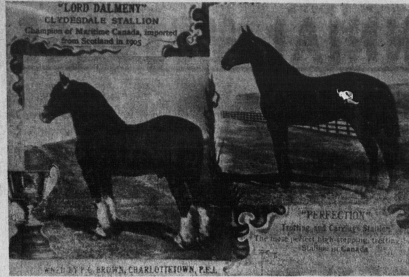
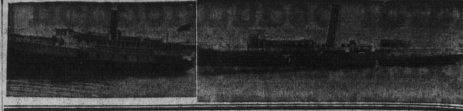


Scenes from another day



ON THIS PAGE pictures show The Island way of life almost from the earliest times in local history and well into the memory of present generations. On the left in the top right is shown Queen Charlotte, wife of George III, after whom the capital city was named. Top left is the first Island postoffice which stood on Water Street just west of Prince Street. Next is the old Methodist Church part of which still stands as a dwelling on lower Prince Street with the fan-shaped upper window still in place. Beside them are two ships the SS Harland and the Northumberland once familiar sights in the harbor.

Centred at top is the old double-decker grandstand on Exhibition Grounds from which thousands watched seven-beat races, while top left are two once-famous horses, Lord Dalmeny, a Clydesdale stallion imported from Scotland in 1903 by owner P.C. Brown, Charlottetown, and Perfection "the most perfect training-bred stallion in Canada."

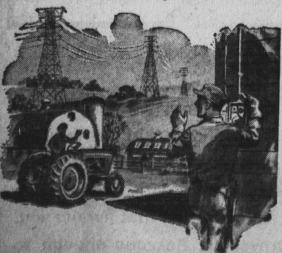
