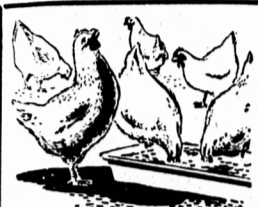

Canadian Y.M.C.A. Military Work. When application was made to the Minister of Militia to send as special service officers, six Y.M.C.A. Secretaries overseas with the First Canadian Expeditionary Force, he responded by not only complying with the request, but granted them honorary commissions in the Canadian Military Force as Captains, and giving them a status similar to that of the regular army chaplains.

Several members of the Y.M.C.A. National Council visited the Valcartier Camp and the six men selected for overseas work had nearly all served at Valcartier. They all had training and experience in Association work, and were chosen because of their special fitness and military experience.

At Sea And At Salisbury Plains. These secretaries had been able, before leaving Valcartier, to distribute to almost every soldier a special tunic pocket song book that had been prepared and printed for the overseas troops.

War Office Recognition. By the autumn of 1915, the overseas work had grown so that administrative staff was needed, and Major Gerald Birks and Mr. W. D. Corbett offered their services, without expense to the Association, for this work.

Business Expanding. HALIFAX - (CP) - A total of 273 new companies were incorporated in Nova Scotia during the last fiscal year, an increase of 63 over the previous year.

At Salisbury Plains they found the British Y.M.C.A. had established work in Y.M.C.A. huts and canteens among the troops. Four days after the Canadians arrived, it began to rain, and rain fell on 82 days during the next 91 at the camp.

When the Canadian Division moved to France, it became a unit of the British Expeditionary Force, and the War Office did not include Y.M.C.A. officers in the final draft; however, Canadian officers became their sponsors, and four secretaries crossed with their units; another secured permission from the Postoffice Office in London, and overtook his unit one day after it reached the front line.

France, 1915. The British Y.M.C.A. made their canteens, which supplied the soldiers with comforts, eats, tea, coffee, sports goods, etc., a chief feature of their work; in the early days these were only at the bases. The Canadian Association at that time felt that the canteen service could be left to the military, and no financial provision had been made for such a service.
