

# Rich creamy frostings

## BROWN SUGAR SAUCE

1/2 cup brown sugar  
1 1/2 tsp. flour  
1 cup boiling water  
1 tsp. butter  
1/2 tsp. vanilla  
Mix flour and sugar. Add water. Cook until floury taste is gone. Remove and add butter and vanilla.

Serve hot.

## CHOCOLATE SAUCE

1 1/2 cup boiling water  
1/2 cup sugar  
Boil together for 5 minutes:  
1/2 cup cocoa  
1/2 tsp. salt  
1 1/2 tsp. corn starch  
1/2 cup cold water  
Mix together, and add to hot mixture. Cook until thick.

Serve hot or cold.

## SEVEN MINUTE FROSTING

1 cup granulated or firm-packed brown sugar  
1/2 tsp. cream tartar

3 tsp. cold water

few grains salt  
1 unbeaten egg white  
1 tsp. vanilla

Measure the sugar and cream of tartar (if brown sugar is used, omit cream tartar) into a double-boiler.

Add water, salt and egg white and beat at high speed for 7 minutes or until frosting stands in peaks.

Remove from heat add vanilla quickly spread over top and sides of cake.
