MONTREAL

MONTREAL (CP) - Stocks plunged in moderately active trading Wednesday on the Montreal and Canadian stock exchanges. Industrial volume was 346,200 shares and mines and oils 1,435,400.

The composite index was off 2 1/4 at 160.4. Industrials were off 2 1/2 at 167 1/2. Canada Cement fell 1 1/2 points to 56 1/2 and Du Pont 1 1/2 points to 50 1/2.

Brinco advanced 1/2 to 35 1/2. Banks were off 2 1/2 at 123 1/2. Imperial Commerce dropped 1/2 points to 66 1/2 and Nova Scotia one point to 77. Royal fell two points to 76 1/2 and Canadienne Nationale 1 1/2 to 73.

Papers were off 2 1/2 at 134. Consolidated lost 1 1/2 points to 43 1/2 and MacMillan-Bloedel 1/2 to 31 1/2. Fraser was off 3/4 at 37 1/2.

Metals were lower in the base section, Hudson Bay Mining lost two points to 76 and Consolidated Mining and Smelting 1 1/2 points to 43 1/4.

In machinery issues, Massey-Ferguson fell 1/2 to 30 1/2 and Fleetwood 1/2 to 20 1/2.
