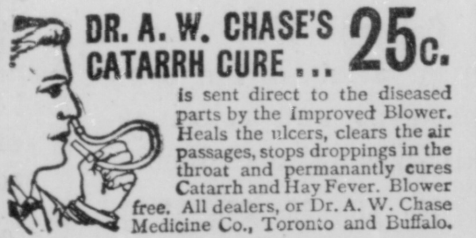

KRUGER'S SPEECH AT JOUBERT'S FUNERAL

The last African mail brings the report of a remarkable prophetic oration delivered by President Kruger at the funeral of Joubert, which no English paper has yet published. President Kruger frequently broke down during the delivery. He said:

"Brothers, sisters, burghers and friends: Only a few words can I say to you, for the spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak. We have lost our brother, our friend, our commandant-general. I have lost my right hand. Not of yesterday, but my right hand since we were boys together, many long years ago.

"To-night I alone seem to have been spared of the old people of this cherished land, of men who lived and struggled together for our country. He has gone to heaven whilst fighting for liberty which God has told us to defend; for freedom which he and I have struggled together so many years and so often to maintain. Brothers, what shall I say to you in this our greatest day of sorrow, in this hour of national gloom?"

"The struggle we are engaged in is for the principle of justice and righteousness which our Lord has taught us is the broad road to heaven and blessedness. It is our sacred duty to keep on that path if we desire a happy ending of our dear, dead brother who has gone on that road to his eternal life. What can I say of his personality? It is only a few short weeks ago that I saw him at the fighting front humbly and nobly taking his share of privations and the rough work of the campaign like the poorest burgher. A true general! A true Christian example to his people! Let me tell you the days are dark. We are suffering reverses on account of the wickedness being rampant in our land. No success will come, no blessings be given to our great cause unless you remove the bad elements from amongst us, and then you may look forward to attaining crowning reward of righteousness and noble demeanor. Let the world rage round us and enemies decry us, the Lord will stand by you against the ruthless hand of the foe, and at the moment when He deems it best for interference peace will come once more."

Vickers was wounded on the day of the surrender of Cronje. His wound was not serious, and was hurt by a Gordon Highlander, who bayoneted him in the hip in the dark as they were rushing back on the trenches. Vickers dislikes his present post, and says that he escaped and was going ahead with the second Canadian contingent, when he was caught by a superior officer and threatened with six months in gaol, which he did not get.

LORD ROBERTS STRATEGY.

A despatch to the London Times from Taaibosch ascribes the successful passage of the Vaal River by the advance guards to Gen Roberts' strategic redistribution of his front, which completely upset the calculations of the Boers, four thousand of whom were expecting Gen. Hamilton at Engelbach Drift. Meanwhile, the British Mounted Troops pushed across to Viljoen's Drift. The correspondent describes the skirmish which followed this movement and which accounted for four casualties mentioned by Gen. Roberts. This was an affair apparently of only a few minutes. The chief oppser of the British was Blake's Irish Brigade.
