UPEI WORLD PROBLEMS SERIES presents POLAND TODAY
March 25, at 8:00 p.m.

An internationally recognized specialist in Polish affairs, Dr. Adam Bronke will speak in the UPEI World problems series on Thursday, March 25. Dr. Bronke's visit is sponsored by the Christian Culture Committee of the Board of Governors of St. Dunstan's University. The title of his talk is "Poland Today", and it will be given at Holy Redeemer Parish Center at 8:00 p.m.

A native of Warsaw, Poland, Dr. Bronke is chairman of the Department of Political Science at McMaster University.

On Friday, March 26, Dr. Bronke will hold an informal session in the UPEI Chaplaincy Centre, with political science students and others. At noon he will be guest speaker in the Chelsea Luncheon Lecture Series held on campus.

Born in 1928, Dr. Bronke served in the Polish underground from 1943-45 and with the Polish forced under British command from 1945-47.

He was educated at the University of St. Andrew, (M.A.) 1950; University of Montreal, Ph.D. in Slavic Studies, (1953), and McGill University, Ph.D. in political science.

The guest lecturer taught Slavic studies and political science at the University of Montreal and McGill university before joining Carleton University in 1962.

HE served as Chirman of Soviet and East European studies, and as Chirman of the Department of Political Science. Earlier in his career he attended Harvard University as a research fellow, and was a visiting lecturer at Boston University.

His writings include The Communist States at the Cross Roads - Praeger, 1965; and Poland's Politics: Political Idealism versus Political Realism - Harvard University Press, 1965.

At the Thursday night lecture Dr. Reginald Stuart will be moderator, and Dr. Thomas Spira, discussant. Both are members of the UPEI Dept. of History.
