That Body Of Yours

IMPLANTING OF THYROID GLAND TISSUE FOR DISEASES OF JOINTS

Because of its action on the body processes, the thyroid gland has been called the "balance wheel" of the body. If the mind and body seem overactive, it is because too much thyroid juice is being poured into the blood; if underactive, not enough thyroid juice is being released into the blood.

In some persons, there is so much overactivity of the thyroid gland that it is called "goiter" and all or part of the thyroid gland is removed by surgery or X-rays. In others, there is so much underactivity of the thyroid gland that thyroid gland extract is given every day to bring the thyroid action up to or near normal.

It was typical of all the patients that exhaustion and pleasant fatigue or occasional increased pain in the joints occurred within 8 to 12 hours after the implantation of thyroid, while considerable improvement of pain and use of the joints was obtained within an additional 24 to 36 hours.

Seven Days A Week

Chill several hours before serving.

FIG FILLED COOKIES One-half cup shortening (preferably butter), 1 cup white sugar, 2 eggs, 3/4 cups sifted cake flour, 1 teaspoon each soda and vanilla, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1/2 cup sour milk. Cream together the shortening and sugar until light. Add vanilla and beat in eggs. Measure the sifted flour and sift it with the salt and soda. Add the dry ingredients alternately with the sour milk, beating until dough is smooth. Roll out on floured board to 1/4 inch thickness and cut out with small round cookie cutter.
