Canadian Canners lost 1-1/4 points while General Dynamics was 1-1/8 lower. Algoma slipped 3-4. Halfpoint dips were posted by Smelters Walker, and Sicks Breweries. Other lower issues were Aluminium, Noranda, Gattineau, International Petroleum and Asbestos, each down 1-4.

Bathurst A and Building Products gained 1-2 point each. Quarterly improvements were made by Fraser and Corby A. National Steel Car, Canadian Industries and Brown leaned forward minor fractions.

Miscellaneous industries, steel beverages and carriers retreated while a mixed tone ruled the banks and papers. Senior oils and utilities were slightly better.

Railroads started out well and then sagged in the end. Steels also were lower together with radio-television, distillers and many chemicals.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks clearly showed the irregular effect of price movements. The average lost 10 cents with the industrial component up 20 cents at a new high of \$188.60 while railroads were off 50 cents and utilities remained unchanged.

Canadian stocks were lower. Canadian Pacific, Dome Mines, McIntyre and Distillers Seagram each dropped 1-4; Hiram Walker fell 1-8. International Nickel was higher, up 1-8.

Giant Yellowknife, Canadian issue on the American stock exchange, eased 1-8.
