Opening lead — king of clubs. If you could see your partner's cards, bidding problems would practically disappear. In the same way, if you could see the defender's cards, the question of how to play a hand would be that much simpler.

Since the opponents will seldom be kind enough to show you their hands, your job as declarer is to learn as much as possible about how their cards are constituted, and play accordingly.

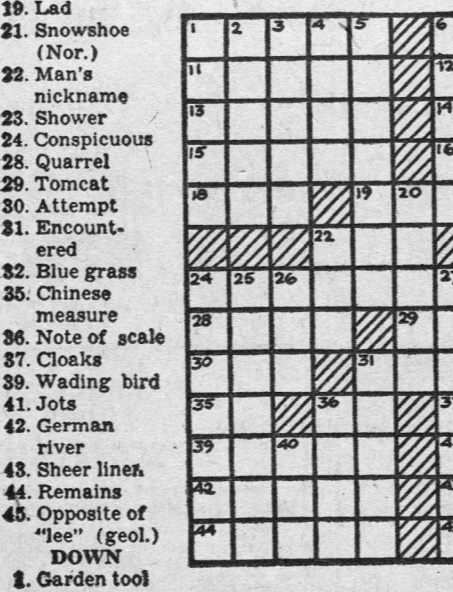
West took the K-Q of clubs, East playing the 2-8, and shifted to the two of spades. Declarer ducked in dummy and East won with the king and returned the three of spades.

So declarer finessed and made the contract as a result of his well-reasoned analysis.
