clear that food allergy is only one cause of eczematous dermatitis of the hands, other causes may be contact dermatitis (where hands come in contact with various sub-

stances), fungus, eruptions, drug eruptions, sweat eruptions and neurogenic (nerve) conditions, though eruptions due to nerves or emotional disturbances are not found as often as other causes.

After outlining symptoms or reactions from the above substances, the diet presented is made up of a group of foods that are least likely to cause a reaction. The basic diet used for the past five years consists of beef, salmon, cabbage, Ry-Krisp, berries, pears, prunes, tea, salt and sugar.

In preparing the diet, the patient must be cautioned not to add other foods in preparation of the meal—beefsteak must be broiled and not fried in butter or lard.

The importance of the diet is emphasized by the fact that no local treatment—drugs, X-ray, is prescribed. Some loss of weight may occur as Carbohydrates (starches) are kept low in amount.

The foods causing the largest number of reactions are wheat, tomato, pork, tuna fish (40 to 50 per cent).

Next, causing 30 to 40 per cent reactions are pineapple, eggs, lamb, chicken, chocolate, coffee.

Next, causing 20 to 30 per cent are: asparagus, white potato, apples, peas, beets, peaches, sweet potato, corn, peanuts.

Next, causing 11 to 20 per cent: raisins, onion, spinach, oatmeal, carrots, apricots, oranges, cherries, lettuce, cucumbers.

Causing the least reactions, 10 per cent or less: beef, prunes, cabbage, salmon, peas, lemons, tea.

The basic diet mentioned above is usually given for four days. As these foods furnish his whole diet, too much of one food, to which he is sensitive may be taken and cause symptoms. Another food may then be substituted. After the four days the patient adds one food every second day.
