MONTREAL, Aug. 2 —(AP)—Butter was a fraction easier on open produce markets here today while eggs and cheese held unchanged, the Dominion Department of Agriculture reported. Potatoes were firm to up a trifle. Creamery butter prints to retailers sold for 22 1-2-23 cents a pound and solids for 22-22 1-2. Western butter delivered in Montreal was unquoted. Quebec No 1 pasteurized in wholesale jobbing lots made 21 1-2. Ontario white and colored cheese were both quoted at 11 3-4. Quebec white was quoted at 10 3-4 and colored at 10 7-8.

Graded egg shipments in used free cases sold at 28-29 cents a dozen for A-large, 26-27 for A-medium, 19 for B-large, 14 for C. Potatoes: Quebec new crop No. 1 75's 80-85; Quebec new crop No. 2 75's 65-70.

A drop of .05 of a cent in terms of the United States dollar pared almost in half Tuesday's sharp run-up. Bankers termed the decline a "not unexpected" reaction.
