## Seal-Hunting Regulations Discovered Less Drastic

HALIFAX (CP)—A detailed explanation of Canada's new seal-hunting regulations here indicated this controversial conservation measure is less drastic than originally believed.

Ross Homans, assistant area fisheries director for the Maritimes, said in an interview that the season kill limit of 50,000 seals for Canadian hunters will apply only to young seals less than a year old. There will be no limit on the number of older seals killed.

"Ambiguous" wording of the regulations had led to confusion that was cleared up to some extent at a meeting of fisheries officers here.

Most sealing captains, reporters and even some fisheries officials had taken the regulations to mean that only 50,000 seals of all ages could be killed. This had drawn sharp criticism from veteran sealing captains, particularly in Newfoundland.

The regulations, adopted this year for the first time, are designed to ensure that enough young seals are left to rejuvenate the herds that every spring drift on Arctic ice down past Labrador into the Gulf of St. Lawrence and off the northeast coast of Newfoundland. The new rules follow complaints of inhumane and wasteful killing methods.

The newly-born seals, called "white coats" by seal hunters, usually are the most sought after because their fur brings the best price.

Mr. Homans explained the regulations to a group of fisheries officers who will accompany the hunters this spring to enforce and advise about the new rules.

Each sealing ship will carry one officer. Airborne seal hunters will be checked by officers

stationed ashore on the Magdalen Islands in the Gulf. Others will patrol the ice floes in helicopters. A tally of young seals killed will be taken at the end of each day.

**DEFINES AREA**  
Mr. Homans said airborne hunters will be permitted to operate only in the main Gulf of St. Lawrence area, between 50 degrees north latitude and a line drawn from Cape North in Cape Breton Island to Cape Ray in Newfoundland.

Helicopter and aircraft crews would not be allowed to kill seals outside this zone or on "the front" of the northeast coast of Newfoundland and Labrador.

Canadian dumping duties can be applied when customs appraisers conclude that the price of the imports is less than that prevailing in the home market.

**SYSTEMS DIFFER**  
British automobile manufacturers maintain that their selling price at home includes distribution and advertising costs and therefore must be higher than the selling price in Canada where the distribution and advertising costs are not included.

Canadian advertising costs are reported to be borne by the Canadian distributors rather than the British manufacturers.

Canadian authorities accepted the principle of these selling differences and at one time allowed a 30-per-cent discount on the British home price before deciding whether dumping duties should be applied on the imports.

But over the years that allowable discount was cut to 20 per cent. The number of British passengers cars imported by Canada dropped to 15,046 in 1963 from 22,831 in 1960.

That allowable discount now may be widened again, perhaps to 25 or 30 per cent. If Canada makes this move, it would be applicable not only to Britain but to other countries which may follow similar selling practices.

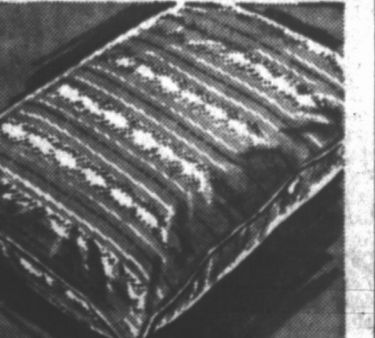
