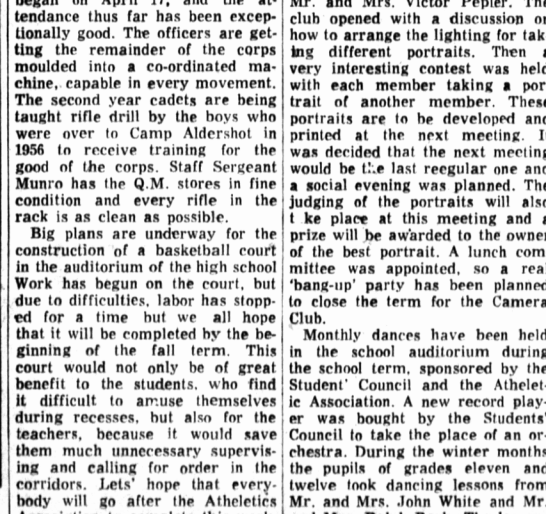
MONTAGUE HI NOTES
