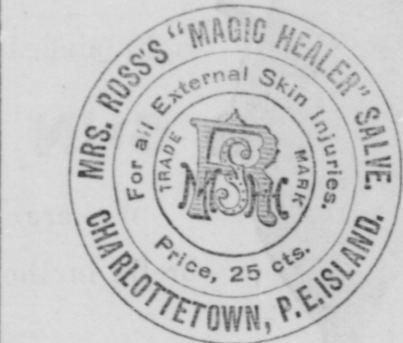
Mr. Joe Howard's theory that one horror of a similar nature follows another to the number of three, has a chance for confirmation this coming summer if certain predictions prove true.

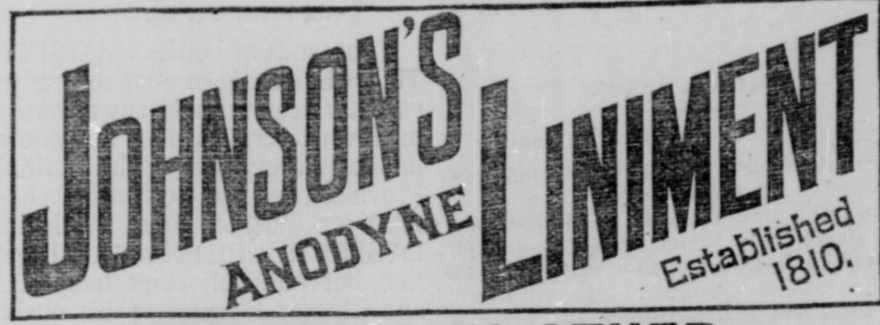
