FINANCIAL AID

Listed below are a few awards which might be of interest.

J.W.DaFoe Graduate Fellowship

\$5000.00 for graduate study in the Departments of Political Studies, Economics, or History at the University of Manitoba. Applicants must intend to work for a higher degree in the field of international studies.

Deadline: January 19

Ontario Graduate Scholarship Program

Holder of this scholarship will receive \$1600.00 per term for two or three consecutive terms. To be eligible students must intend to pursue graduate studies at an Ontario University.

Deadline: Dec.1

Concordia University Graduate Fellowships and the David J. Azbieli Graduate Fellowship

Applications for graduate fellowships are invited from candidates intending to study full-time in a graduate program leading to a master's or doctoral degree at Concordia University. Academic merit, broadly interpreted to include skills, talents and similar factors of relevance to the

candidate's proposed program of study, is the prime consideration in the granting of awards.

Financial need is not taken into account. Awards are normally tenable for the duration of a fellow's full-time graduate study, provided that progress in the graduate program is satisfactory and that any other conditions of tenure have been met. Value: \$6000 a year plus tuition in some cases.
