If there is a touch of humor anywhere in the Bible, it is surely here. No one knew better than St. Paul that there are some men with whom it is impossible to live peaceably.

Once we boasted of our belief that with tact and patience one could get along well with any honest fellow-worker. But a delicate and difficult situation arose in which the financial interests and personal ambitions of certain people were involved.

An honest man cannot be true to himself without opposing openly the betrayal of principles by which he lives.

The exhortation just quoted was written at the victorious close of one of the hottest controversies in the church's history, and in an Epistle which celebrates that victory. And it is from a man who would accept no compromise on the issue in which this Epistle is the last word.

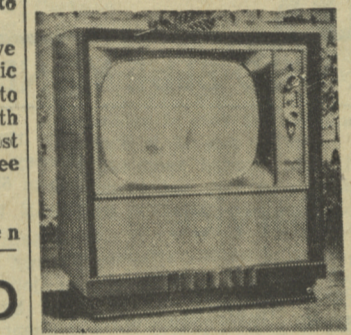
We all recognize the importance of peace in a community—particularly in a small community. Every effort open to citizens of goodwill should be taken to maintain it.

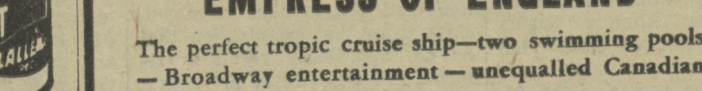

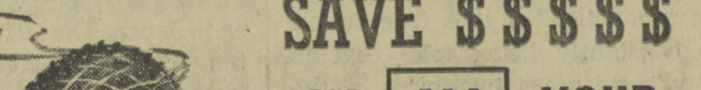

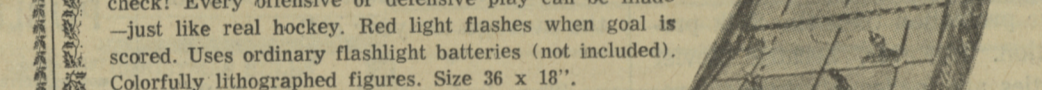
