- A. FIELD OF STUDY

CAL CALLAHAN MEMORIAL BURSARY:

- A. Open
- B. The applicant must be a son or daughter of a person who derives principle income from pipeline construction. The student must be enrolled in first year studies at any recognized university or college in a program leading to a degree or certificate in any field.

PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND TEACHER'S FEDERATION:

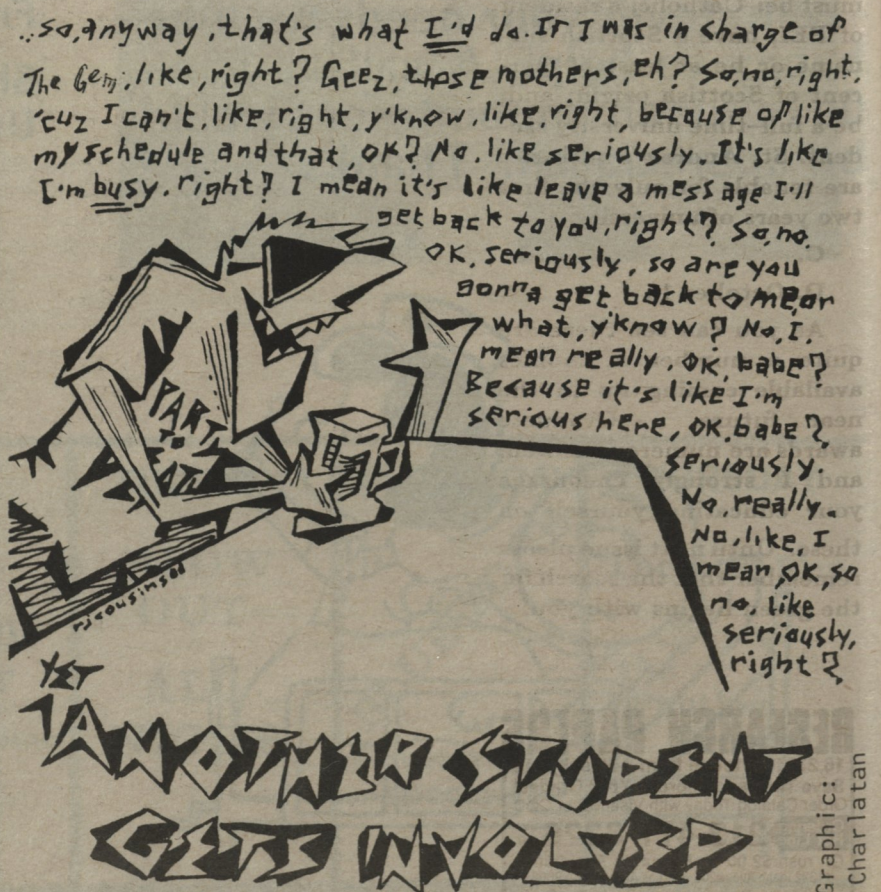
