## Drivers Charged In Souris Court

SOURIS — Two driving while impaired cases were on the docket here Wednesday when Magistrate J. B. Johnston held court here.

Alford Derrick Robertson of Kingsboro was charged with driving while his abilities were impaired by alcohol. No plea was taken and the case was adjourned to Feb. 4 to give the accused time to obtain counsel.

Ronald Bernard Campbell of Campbell's Cove, charged with driving while impaired, pleaded guilty. He was fined \$100 and a cost of 10 days.

Three men were charged with theft to the value of less than \$50. All three had pleaded guilty previously. They were Peter Daniel McIntyre, Sylvanus Joseph MacDonald, and James Albert McIntyre, all of Souris. They were given a one-year suspended sentence. Each man was required to post a bond of \$500 and obtain two sureties, each a \$250 bond.

John Francis McIntyre of Souris appeared charged with fishing in a closed area. He is captain-overseer of the district Fan and Jo Anne. The charges concern alleged fishing in a closed area off Basin Head, closed by the government to dragger fishing and fisheries officers. Claude Norman Richards, Souris; Elmore MacLean Mackay, Charlottetown; and Lee Daniel Darach, West Royalty.

J. P. Nicholson represented the defendant and Charles McQuid the Crown.

Fines of \$20 and costs or 15 days were levied in three cases of intoxication, and \$20 and costs or 30 days in two cases of possession of liquor in a place other than a residence.

## Preliminary Hearing Opens At Geo'town In Assault Case

GEORGETOWN — The preliminary hearing of John James Cheverie, New Zealand charged with indecently assaulting Mrs. Andrew Gregory was held in the court house in Georgetown Wednesday night before Kings County Magistrate James R. Johnston, Q.C.

The offence is alleged to have been committed at Gowan Brae, last Oct. 27.

Four Crown witnesses gave evidence at Wednesday's hearing. They were: Mrs. Mary Bernadette Sheehan of Souris, Alfred Gregory of Souris, 1111 1/2 Road, Mrs. R. A. Rouen of the RCMP crime detection laboratory at Sackville, N.B. and Dr. John H. Maloney of Charlottetown.

Twenty Crown exhibits were placed in evidence. The evidence of five Crown witnesses still remains to be heard.

## Committee Head Is Going To Sask.

While on the trip, she will visit Retarded Children centres in Winnipeg, Toronto and Montreal to meet members of her committee. The tour should take nearly 10 days, when her stops have been included.

## Souris Man Represents P.E.I.

Paul Gallant, Eastern Fishes Society, left yesterday for Ottawa to represent the P. E. I. Fisheries Federation, of which he is past president, at a presentation to be made by the Fisheries Federation of Canada to the federal cabinet.

The brief to be presented deals with the contentious question of territorial waters, a subject which has been under close study for a long period of time and on which the federation has prepared a comprehensive report.
