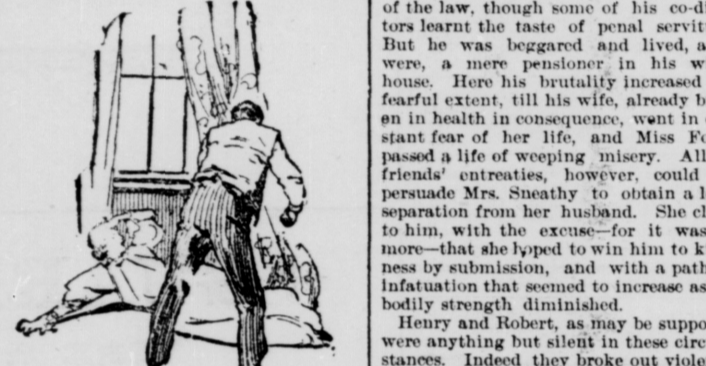


THE CHRONICLES OF MARTIN HEWITT BY ARTHUR MORRISON THE ASH OF THE MISSING LINK

(Copyright 1895.) CHAPTER I.

I think I have recorded in another place Hewitt's frequent saying that "there is nothing in this world that is at all possible that has not happened or is happening in London." But there are many strange happenings in this matter of fact, country, and in these matter-of-fact times, that occur far enough from London.
