## Nine Dead, 10 Injured In Fire

CHICAGO (AP)—Nine persons died and 10 were injured early Sunday in a fire which swept a four-story apartment building on Chicago's south side. Two children were among the dead.  
 Fire Marshal Albert Peterson said more than 100 persons were in the structure when the blaze started on the first floor and swept up a stair well. All were Negroes.  
 Two of the dead were killed in leaps from the fourth floor. Others died of suffocation in their one- and two-room flats. Several of the injured were hurt dropping from second floor windows after a lower stair flight collapsed.  
 Peterson said cause of the fire was undetermined. He estimated damage at \$60,000.

## Smallwood On Javelin Plans

ST. JOHN'S, Nfld. (CP)—Premier Smallwood told the Newfoundland legislature Friday the major part of the money to finance the Canadian Javelin iron ore development at Lake Wabush in Labrador will be raised in Switzerland from Swiss bankers.  
 About \$20,000,000 will be needed to put the Wabush mine into operation, a company statement said.  
 Mr. Smallwood said an amendment would be introduced this session to the bill which guarantees Canadian Javelin a \$16,500,000 bond issue. It will provide among other things that the guarantee be effective in Swiss francs instead of dollars.

## Higher Interest Expected Soon On Bank Loans

TORONTO (CP)—Canadian banks may have to pay higher interest rates on bank loans, it is reported in banking circles.  
 One highly-placed source said "it would not be surprising if the progressive increases of the past year by the Bank of Canada in its bank rate were reflected shortly by a general increase in lending rates as charged by the chartered banks."  
 The Bank of Canada, the country's central banking authority, Wednesday night announced an increase in its rate to a record three per cent, from the previous 2 per cent—effective immediately.  
 It was the fourth increase since August, when the bank departed from an earlier-year "easy money" policy with an increase from the then-existing 1 1/2 per cent to 2 per cent. This was followed in October with an increase to 2 per cent and in November with an increase to 2 1/2 per cent.  
 Thus, in about eight months the rate has been doubled.  
 Purpose of the central bank's increases has been to discourage borrowing which might send too much money after too few goods and cause higher prices.  
 Moves towards tighter money have also been made in the United States and Britain.

DETROIT (AP)—American Motors Sunday announced a new version of its foreign-built Metropolitan model with increased horsepower and broad styling changes.

The Metropolitan, an 85-hp wheelbase, has an over-all length of 149 1/2 inches, is 61 1/2 inches wide and 54 1/2 inches high.

Styling changes include a new oval-shaped grille and side moulding that begins at the headlight.
