Trade was light and prices in both producers and speculators were mixed. The penny issues were, however, stronger.
The exchanges' closing averages show banks up .18 at 46.56, utilities off .3 to 138.3, industrials off .5 to 241.6, papers up .04 to 109.41 and goods unchanged at 67.74.

TORONTO

TORONTO (CP) — Industrials led the stock market in an "irregular advance Tuesday; irregular because base metals went against the trend and closed with a loss as great as the industrial index-gain."
Industrials gained more than a point with base metals off that much. Western oils were ahead a half point and golds a quarter of a point on their indexes.
The market was irregularly lower at the open but as the session progressed, prices in oils began to show signs of improvement, reaching their peaks at the close. Brokers said there was a technical factor behind the advance in the fact that the market had been steadily declining with- out too many breaks for a month and it was due for a rally.
Although senior base metals, which make up the metal index, were fractionally lower in almost a solid line, low-priced mines had several moderate gains and uran- iums were strong.
Index changes: Industrials up 1.15 to 420.96; metals up .25 to 77.92; base metals off 1.14 to 147.62; western oils up .53 to 125.27.
