

Farm Prices And Products

POTATOES
 The potato market has apparently levelled off a bit since the high which was reached about the first of last week. Today the top price being paid for the contents of a 75-pound bag is \$3.75. This price may vary slightly between different points. The holdings of potatoes are extremely heavy in both Montreal and Toronto, and information is that yesterday in Montreal there were 180 cars of potatoes on the track and over 30 in Toronto. The American holdings on Monday of this week were 1,900 cars on track, and yesterday this amount was down to approximately 1,400. Since our last report 48,354 bushels of seed were shipped from the Province.
 The demand for turnips is considerably easier since our last report, and the prices being offered today are from 90c to \$1.00 per bushel at the car.

EGGS AND POULTRY

Egg production is now at its peak. Receipts are heavy and stocks are accumulating. A steady movement of the product continues to other Atlantic Provinces but not in sufficient quantity to clear all supplies.
 Paying prices have been reduced. Charlottetown stations are now quoting for ungraded eggs delivered AL 35, AM 33, B 22, C 13-15. Dealers quoting for graded pack delivered Charlottetown AL 40, AM 38, B 28, C 20, and are quoting retailers in cartons AL 44-45, AM 42-43, B 32-33.
 Richmond: Ungraded eggs—AL 36, AM 34, B 22, C 16; Summer-side: Ungraded eggs—AL 35, AM 33, B 20, C 15; St. Peter's: Ungraded eggs—AL 35, AM 33, B 20, C 15.
 Poultry receipts are practically all with paying prices unchanged. Chicken over five pounds, 38c; Owl over five pounds, 30c.
 Unfortunately necessary to draw the attention of egg station operators that there are complaints being received regarding wet egg cases. It is apparent that some station operators are using cases which contain a high percentage of moisture. This type of case should not be used. Trays which the eggs are packed in will draw this moisture, resulting in soft wet trays and mould development. If station operators continue to use this type of container their eggs will be detained and returned to them. It is up to the operators to use only new, dry, clean cases and new trays.

DAIRYING

The price of butter on the Halifax market remained unchanged during the past week; the wholesale price for one and two-pound prints being quoted at 63c delivered, with local jobbing at 65c. On the Saint John market the wholesale price for one and two-pound prints delivered has dropped to 61c, and the local jobbing price is quoted at 63c delivered.
 Montreal current receipts were 87½c on April 15, which is a decrease of 3½c per pound within the past two weeks. The wholesale price for first-grade solids is now quoted at 58½-58½c.
 In Toronto the wholesale price is 57½-58c, and the local jobbing price in this Province is 55c.
 The production of butter is increasing in this Province at the present time, but is still keeping about 20 per cent below last year's level. There were about 1,130,000 pounds of butter moved out of storage in the Maritimes during the month of March. On April 1, 1955, there were 225,000 pounds in storage in the Maritimes, which is only 236,000 pounds more than at this same time last year. It would appear that there will be less butter in storage in the Maritimes on May 1, 1955, than on May 1, 1954.
 Creamery butter production for Canada for the month of March is down about 6.5% from the March last year. The production from January to March is down 3%. In this Province our butter production for March is 22% below that of last year, and for the three-month period from January to March it is down 18%.
 Canadian cheese production for the month of March is 16% below that of last year, and from January to March is 13% down. In this Province we just produced one-third as much cheese in March of this year as we did in March last year, and for the three-month period we have not produced one-half as much.
 Concentrated milk products in Canada were 8% below that of March last year, but for the January to March period are 2% higher than the previous year. Domestic disappearance of butter in Canada during the month of March was 3% higher than it was the previous year.

WOOL MARKETING

The Prince Edward Island Sheep Breeders' Association are making extensive plans for handling an increased amount of wool this year for the Canadian Co-operative Wool Growers. Those who have wool to dispose of this year will be able to leave this wool at any of their co-operative stores, and other designated centres throughout the Province, where it will be picked up and brought into the wool warehouse here in Charlottetown. The Sheep Breeders' Association will allow seventy-five cents (75c) per one hundred pounds for all wool delivered to their warehouse. The advance this year will be thirty-five cents (35c) per pound, and a rebate will be paid on the 1954 clip, and also on the 1953 clip, for those again shipping through the Sheep Breeders' Association. Further information from time to time will be given the sheep breeders in regard to the handling and selling of their wool.

To Consider Oil Protests

OTTAWA (CP) — The United States has promised to give sympathetic consideration to Canadian protests over proposed U. S. limitations on imports of oil, which the federal government feels would have a damaging effect on the Canadian petroleum industry. The promise is contained in a brief U. S. note tabled in the Commons Thursday by External Affairs Minister Pearson. The note, delivered to the Canadian embassy in Washington Wednesday, is the first written reply to Canada's formal March 8 protest. Mr. Pearson said he hopes that the U. S. in its own interests as well as Canadian, will not interfere in the Canada-U. S. petroleum trade.
