WINNIPEG, July 18 (CP)- Coarse grain throughout most of the moderately active session today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. Barley, however, firmed up towards the close.

Increased offerings, including hedging sales, contributed to the declines. Commercial demand was not as aggressive as of late. Rye saw American houses on both sides of the market, with the selling more predominant, and prices closed near the lows of the day. Flax dealings were light, with the most activity in the July contract.

About 1,200,000 bushels of Canadian wheat were allocated for export today, with the United Kingdom taking 625,000 bushels; Belgium 220,000; Japan 250,000; Colombia 120,000; and Switzerland 30,000.

Class two wheat prices dropped two cents from yesterday.
