Livestock

MONTREAL, July 17 (CP)—Receipts on the Montreal livestock market today were: Cattle 1,007, calves 1,399, sheep 1,027, hogs 921. Hogs were steady, cattle and calves steady to firm, and lambs close to 50 cents higher. Good steers made \$6.75 to 77, medium steers from \$5.50 to \$6.90 and common mostly around \$5. Good heifers were \$5.50 to \$6 with an odd top heifer up to \$6.50. Medium heifers were \$4.25 to \$5.25 and common \$3 to \$4. Good cows as much as \$5.25 with the top at \$5.50. Medium cows were \$4.25 to \$4.75 and common \$3.25 to \$4. Canners and cutters made \$2.50 to \$3. Good veals were firm, other kinds 25 to 50 cents higher, good veals made \$7 to \$7.50 with medium kinds from \$6 to \$6.50 and common veals from \$5 to \$5.50. Grassers and common drinkers ranged from \$3.50 to \$4.50 with the bulk between \$4 and \$4.25. Lambs were fully 50 cents higher. Good ewes and wethers made \$10 with \$1 per cwt. cut on bucks and \$2 per cwt. cut on culls. A-bout 60 per cent of the lambs were sold in mixed lots at \$6.50 to \$9.50 according to quality. Sheep were from \$2.50 to \$4. Hogs were unchanged at \$9.75 for bacon fed and watered. Selects drew \$1 per hog premium with the regular cuts on off grades. Sows were \$5 to \$6. Hogs sold on rail grade brought \$13.25 to \$13.35 cold weight.

CHICAGO, July 17 (AP)—The wheat market developed a strong undertone near the close of trading today and early price losses of the Canadian commodity exchange as much as 7-8 cents were erased. Wheat closed unchanged to 3-8 lower compared with Saturday's finish, July 66-65 7-8, Sept. 66 1-2 5-8, corn unchanged to 1-4 higher, July 44 1-4; Sept. 45 3-8, oats unchanged to 1-4 higher. WISCONSIN, July 17 (AP)—Forecasts of scattered showers in sections of western Canada's spring grain belt plus weakness on outside markets, kept buyers idle on Winnipeg grain exchange today and forced wheat futures prices nearly a cent lower. Final quotations were 3-4-5-8 cent down, with July at 53 3-4, Oct. 54-54 1-8, Nov. 55 5-8, and Dec. 55 5-8 cents. Liverpool values slumped 7-8-1d. Buenos Aires held unchanged.

NATIONAL FORESTRY PROGRAM
Under an Agreement between the Federal Department of Labor and the Government of the Province of Prince Edward Island arrangements have been made to initiate a Forestry Program in this province involving the establishing of between 20 and 30 wood and timber lot improvement areas. These areas will be properly cleaned and improved under the direction of qualified group leaders operating on instructions of officials representing the National Forestry Service and the Department of Agriculture. A total of about fifty-four (54) young men between the age of 18 and 25 inclusive are required to conduct this service. An excellent training in woodlot improvement will be secured by the enrollees. Students making application should be in unemployed circumstances, in good health, possess good character and a fair education. Transportation, tuition, living costs and a reasonable per day allowance will be made. Selections for the work will be made strictly according to the provisions of the Policy by a special Committee appointed for this purpose.
