Fulton Scores Pearson Error

VANCOUVER (CP)—E. David Fulton candidate for national leadership of the Progressive Conservative party charged Wednesday that External Affairs Minister Pearson made a "gross error in judgment" when he voted with Communist countries in the Security Council against Britain "our oldest ally."

Mr. Pearson's vote for immediate withdrawal of British and French forces from Egypt was inconsistent with his later proposal for a United Nations force to police the area, the member of Parliament for Kamloops told meetings at the University of British Columbia and Chilliwack. At Chilliwack, he added: "I cannot understand why Mr. Pearson should vote against Britain and France at the request of the Americans who, next to Russia, had most to do with causing the situation in the Middle East."

Mr. Fulton said he supported the proposal for UN police action. In the first of a series of speeches in his campaign for party leadership, Mr. Fulton said the main plank of the Conservative platform should be the control and development of Canada's natural resources.

"We welcome U.S. capital but we insist that it be used so that the control and benefit of our resources accrue to Canadians. And we believe that a greater share of the tax money should go to the people."
