Don't wait until it's too late to report animal cruelty. The animals can't wait much longer for help—their lives depend on you. Call...

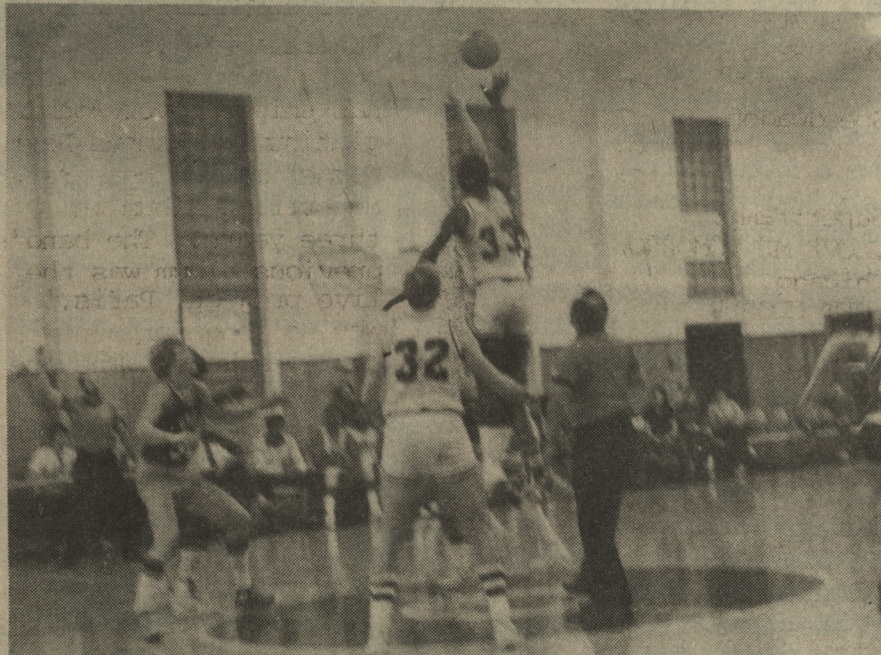
