Grain

WINNIPEG, Aug. 11 — (CP) — Further large-scale export business in Canadian barley was indicated today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange, with an estimated 1,000,000 — three or four cargoes — sold to the continent. As a result good export buying again appeared in barley during coarse grain trading. Commercial demand was generally lighter in other grains. Moderate shipping buying came out in oats and some light export demand in flax. Prices generally were easier, reflecting hesitation on U.S. markets in response to reports of moisture in the dry area of the corn belt. There was no information available on export loadings of Canadian wheat. Class two wheat and I.W.A. prices were up one-eighth cent from Friday. Closing prices: Oats — Oct. 84½; Dec. 81½; Barley — Oct. 1.28½; Dec. 1.24½; Rye — Oct. 1.90½; Dec. 1.90½; May 1.94½-1.95. Flax — Oct. 3.93½; Dec. 3.88½; May 3.92A.
