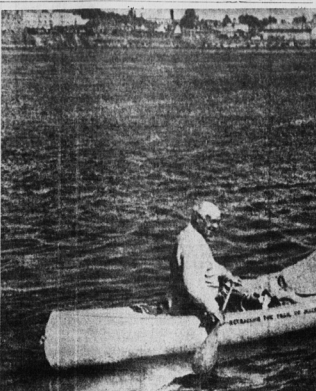

DROUGHT FEARS — HONG KONG (Reuters) — Heavy rain fell Friday, breaking Hong Kong's long drought. The observatory recorded 1.54 inches of rain between midnight and 9 a.m. and further isolated showers were predicted.
