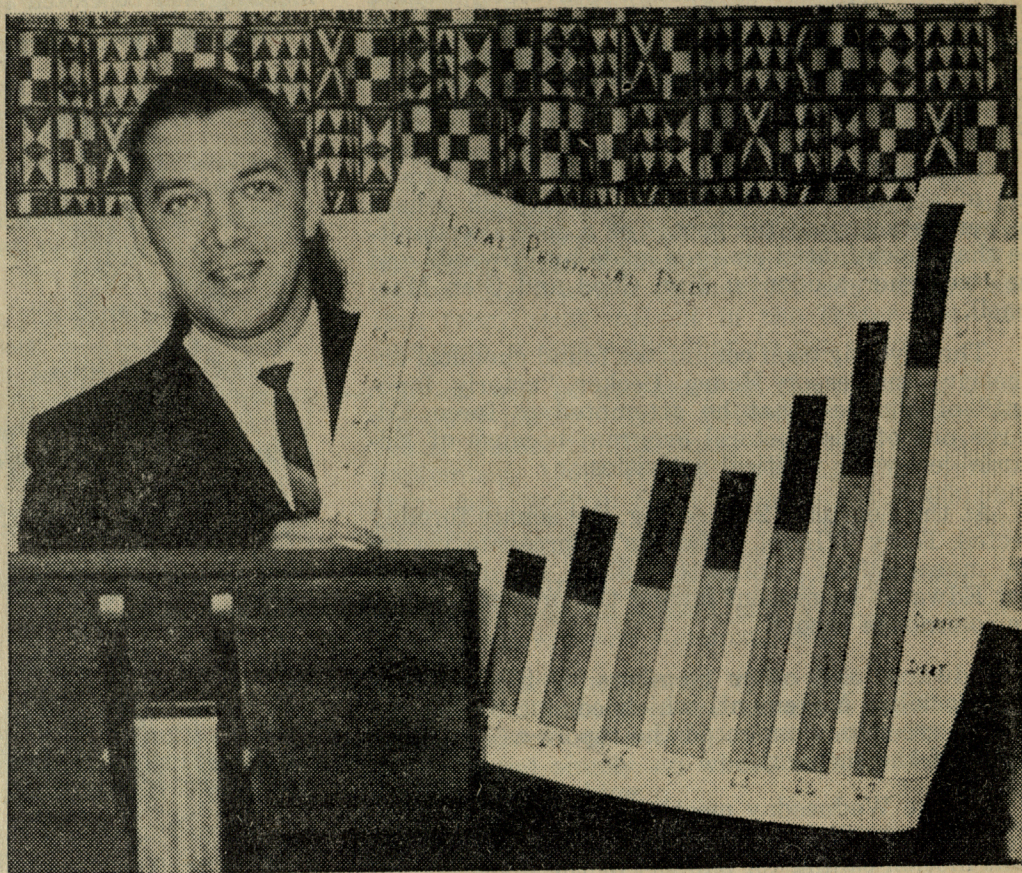


# Smart Alex
