I attend church on rainy Sundays because:

**Our Neighbor as Cursel.**  
Let us recall one another to the simplicity of the Gospel standard. It is the one and one only test for the love of God is the love of our brotherman. If we do not love him whom we can see and touch and know nothing will persuade St. John that we can love God whom we have never seen. This love of our neighbor is to be a moral act; it requires a moral effort. Not easy to love our neighbor with all our heart; not easy when our will desires to wander, loose and free, or to dream its own dreams or brood over our own counsels—not easy to break off from this self-interest and lend our being to another's service! Not easy, either, to love him with all the mind, trying to enter into his veils, to apprehend the reason of his differences from us, to penetrate behind what seems to us so stupid, and to unearth his own self-justification to arrive at his conclusions from his side, to care for him enough to take pains about him, so that we may not misjudge him.—Canon Scott Holland.
