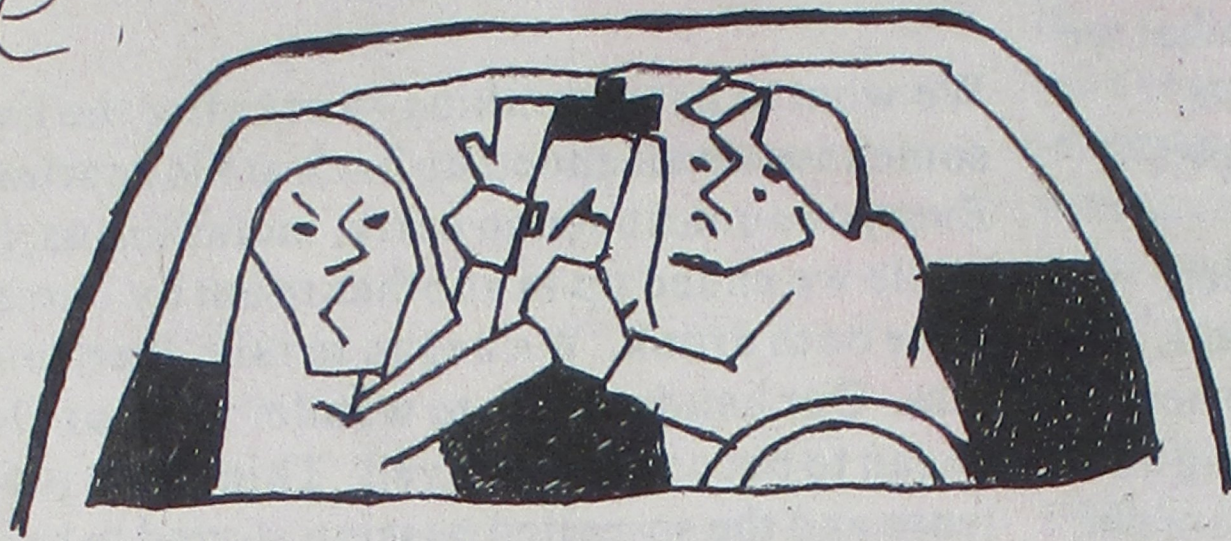


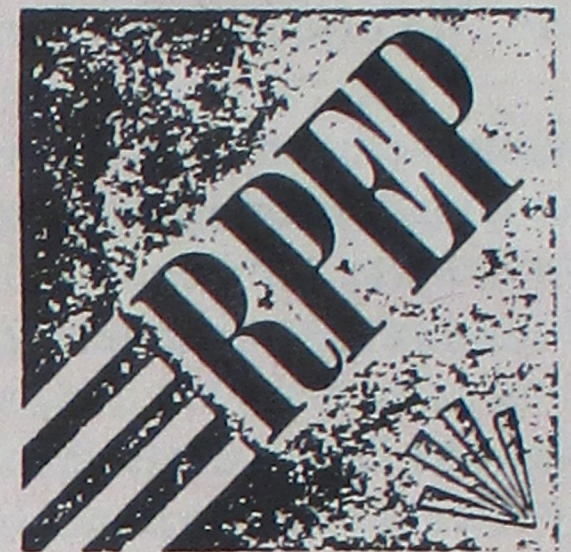

## DATING RIGHTS

### Take Care of Yourself

↓  
Respect your friends. Listen to what they say about how far they do - or don't - want to go.

↓  
Say what you mean.  
Communicate clearly.

↓  
If you drink, stay in control. Decide your limits in advance. Many date rapes involve the use of alcohol and/or drugs by the woman, man or both.

↓  
Be sure everyone has a safe and escorted way home. Don't leave a friend stranded.

↓  
Women, say "yes" when you mean "yes" and "no" when you mean "no."  
Be direct and don't hint.

↓  
Men, take a "no" as "no" the first time.  
Don't push, persist or force.

↓  
Sex with a woman too drunk to consent is a criminal act - rape - not a sexual act.  
If it's against her will, it's against the law.

↓  
Party with self-assurance and self-insurance.
