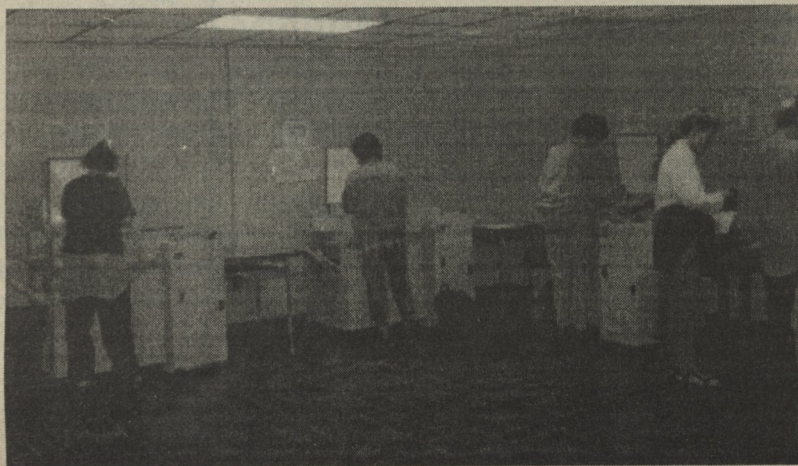


ROBERTSON LIBRARY STAFF

Visit the Library early in the semester, and often.

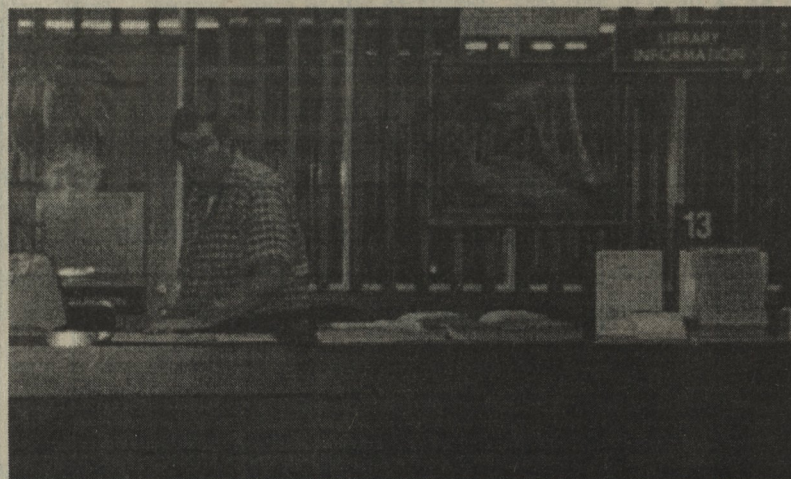
Always carry your Library card with you. Beware of lending your card to someone else; if items are late or lost, it is you and not your friend who will receive an overdue billing.

Visit our Home Page. Just log on to one of the Internet access microcomputers in Room 103 behind The Pit. Click Windows 3.1, Internet Applications, and Netscape. From the UPEI Home Page, we're just one click away! Check out University Librarian Dan Savage's Welcome Message.

If you are not registered in any courses that include a Library tour early in the semester, drop by the Information Desk to see if you can join a tour that is already scheduled.

Ask someone at the Information Desk to show you how to use Bobcat, the Library's catalogue, or any of the printed reference sources or CD-ROM databases.

Don't leave empty-handed! If you come to the Library for something and cannot find it, ask Information Desk staff to assist you.
