LONDON (Reuters) — British movie critics Wednesday praised a new production by the National Film Board of Canada on the royal visit to Ottawa. "Brilliant," "handsome," and "seldom equalled" are some of the adjectives used to describe The Scriptures and the Mass, a 30-minute color documentary by John Howe. The Daily Mirror's Donald Zec calls it "one of the finest films" if not the finest ever, featuring Queen Elizabeth and Prince Philip.

The Times' critic writes that the National Film Board has turned "spectacle into emotion as a way the recording camera has seldom equalled."

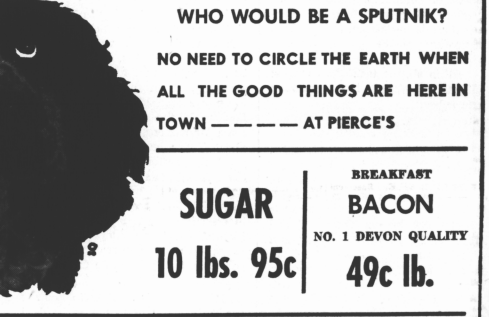

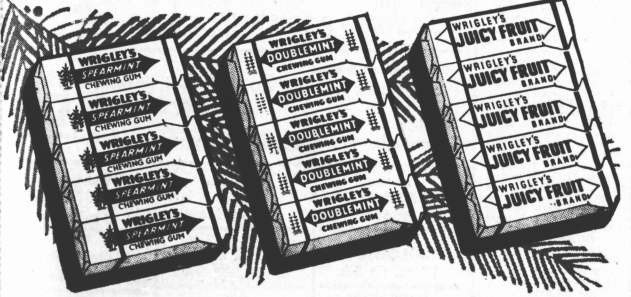
