## Food 101: For Students Who Cook

### MULTILINGUAL DELIGHT: FRENCH TOAST

The French call this English Toast; the English call it French Toast - but French Toast by any other name tastes just as sweet.

Preparation time: 5 minutes  
 Cooking time: 10 minutes  
 Serves two

Combine in a large bowl:  
 2 eggs  
 1/4 tsp. (1 mL) salt  
 1/4 tsp. (1 mL) pepper  
 1/4 cup (60 mL) milk  
 1/2 tsp. (2 mL) vanilla extract (optional)  
 Beat vigorously with a fork or whisk.

Dip into mixture:  
 4 slices bread  
 Heat in a frying pan over medium heat:  
 1 tsp. (5 mL) butter or margarine

Place dipped bread in frying pan.  
 Fry until brown, then turn and fry until other side is brown.



**Don't Start Without:**  
 frying pan  
 large bowl  
 fork  
 measuring spoons  
 measuring cup

**Helpful Hints:**  
 • Always cook French Toast on medium to low heat, since the eggs will burn if fried too quickly.  
 • Don't leave bread sitting in the mixture, since it tends to get soggy and fall apart.

**Serving Ideas:**  
 • French Toast can be topped with jam, maple syrup or corn syrup.
